

## Rustling continues in 3 counties

Reports of cattle rustling are continuing across the three-county area of Lancaster, Lebanon and Berks.

Ivan S. Zimmerman, R2 East Earl, Lancaster County, this week reported 16 Jersey heifers missing from winter pasture. The animals could have been taken on several occasions since September 22, according to Zimmerman. Their value was placed at \$12,000.

Last week, four bulls were stolen from the barn of Norman Kline at Reistville in Lebanon County. Through a cooperative effort of

Myerstown police and New Jersey State Police, the animals were located and subsequently returned. A New Jersey couple was charged with receiving stolen goods and released on bail. On the night of the theft, Myerstown police spotted a pickup truck and horse trailer with New Jersey tags driving through town.

Early Tuesday morning, a fire of suspicious origin destroyed the Kline barn from which the four bulls had been stolen.

Despite the flames and extreme heat, firemen from

Schafferstown and Myerstown were able to free 21 bulls in the barn. Without special equipment, firemen were wet down and entered the blazing barn to save the livestock. No one was injured.

At the scene of the fire, a stolen Ryder rental truck was found, along with a cap believed to come from a gas can. Investigation is continuing.

Friends and neighbors within a six-mile radius gathered at the Kline farm on Tuesday and Wednesday to clean up the fire debris.

The Kline family has expressed its appreciation for the assistance.

About a mile away, two bulls were taken from the Moses Garman farm late last year.

Additional incidents of recent livestock thefts have been reported in other areas of Lebanon County, near Churchtown in Lancaster County and in the Kutztown area of Berks County.
