Order 4 price \$14.13 for April

ALEXANDRIA, VA — Middle Atlantic Order Market Administrator Joseph D. Shine Wednesday announced a Class I milk price of \$14.13 per hundredweight for April 1980.

This price is two cents below the March price, but up 83 cents from last April. Order No. 4 prices are announced for milk testing 3.5 percent butterfat, f.o.b. plants located within 55 miles of Philadelphia, and also within 75 miles from the nearer of Washington, DC or Baltimore, MD.

There is also a 6-cent direct-delivery differential applicable to producer milk received at plants located within 55 miles of Philadelphia.

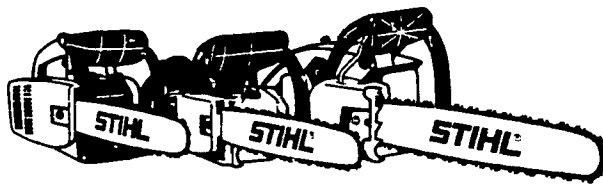
Shine announced a Class II milk price of \$11.39 per hundredweight for February 1980 and a butterfat differential of 15.0 cents for the month. The Class II milk price was down three cents from the previous month while the butterfat differential did not change.

These class prices are based on the February 1980 Minnesota-Wisconsin manufacturing milk price of \$11.35 per hundredweight adjusted to a 3.5 percent butterfat content.

The USDA reported the wholesale price of Grade A butter at Chicago for February was \$1.3028 per

pound and the nonfat dry milk price was \$.8378 per pound, f.o.b. plants in the Chicago area.

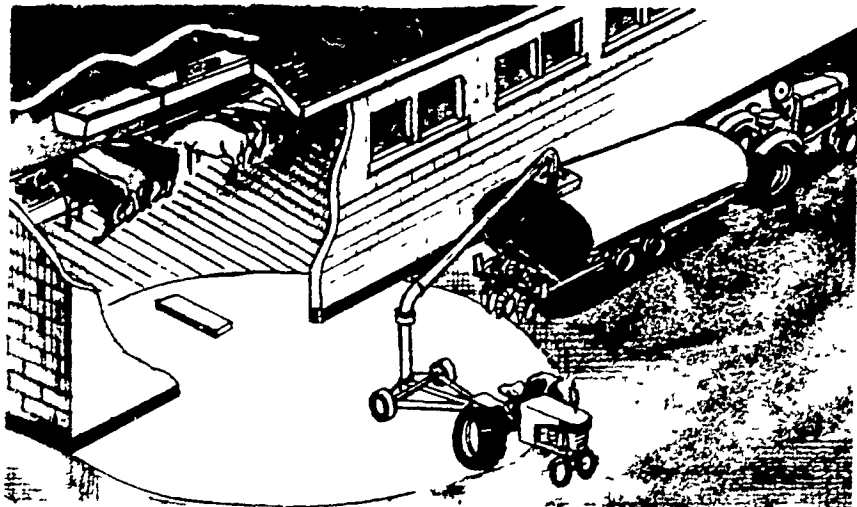

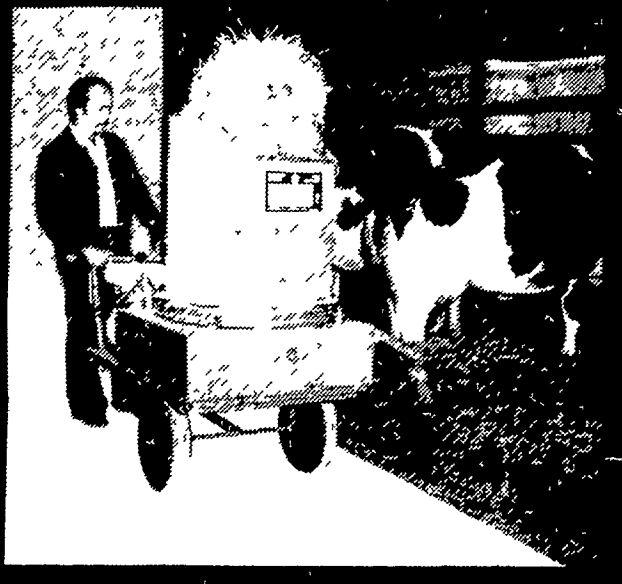
