They have an 18,000 pound herd average with 620 fat on 66 head. It is the home of Dunwood Chief Carmel, who is projected to have 24,000 pounds milk and 1,000 pounds fat this year.

Next stop will be the Ken Mowery farm where they milk 205 head of cows with 16,500 pound herd average.

Then farmers will hop over the mountain to Singing Brook Farm owned by Mr. and Mrs. Obie Snider. They milk 125 head, with a herd average of 17,000 pounds.

The last stop is the home of Polled Holsteins, Burket Falls Farm, owned by Mr. and Mrs. Dave Burket.

Dinner will be at Chilcoat's Restaurant and it will be a family style meal. Bring a bag lunch with you. Tour is expected to return about 9 p.m.
