The Lancaster County Bankers Award, a money award for the outstanding senior in agriculture, was given to Glenn Shenk.

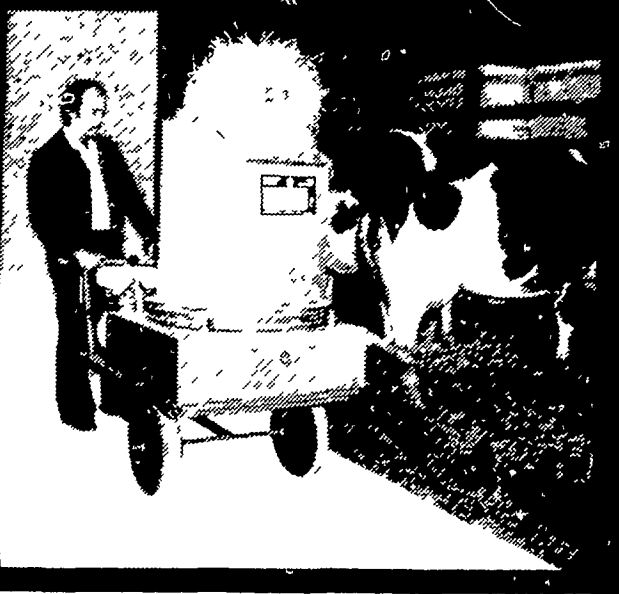
The Production Credit Award of Lancaster County was presented to Barry Geib. It is annually given to an agriculture student who

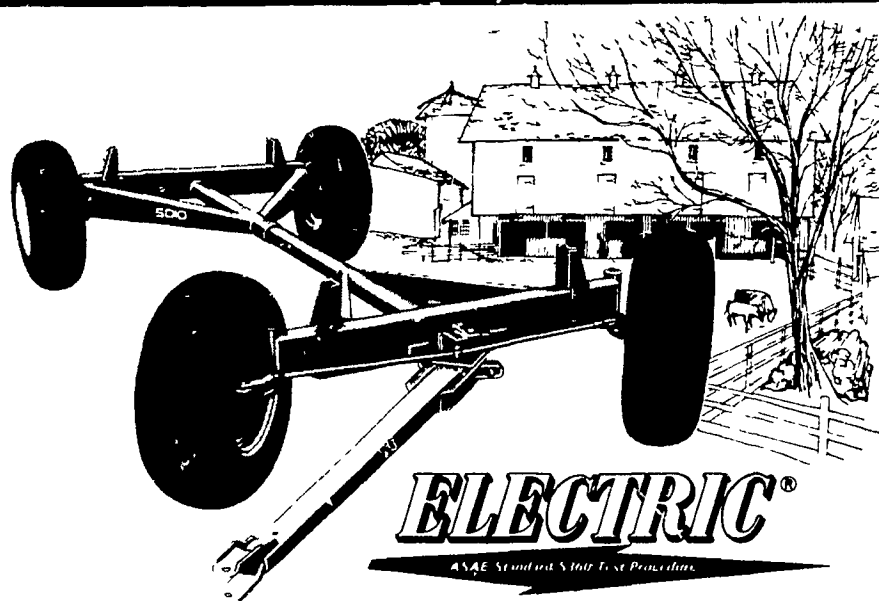

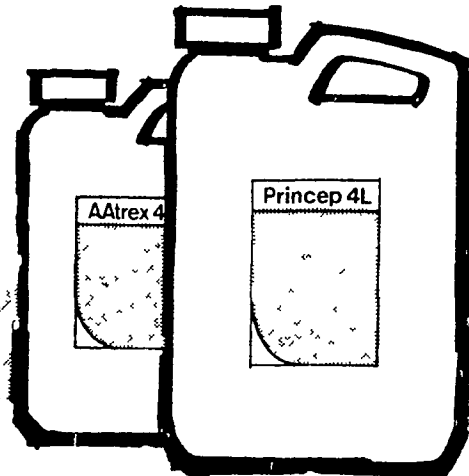
