Conn. livestock dealer suspended

POMFRET CENTER, Conn. — Russell E. Avery, Inc., a livestock dealer of Pomfret Center, Conn., has been suspended and ordered to stop violating bonding and payment requirements of the Packers and Stockyards Act.

Avery, who bought livestock in Connecticut and Vermont, is not operating at present.

The order was issued in default after the firm failed to answer an administrative complaint filed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

Avery was ordered to cease and desist from:

Failing to pay when due for livestock purchases and failing to pay the full purchase price for livestock; and

Operating without maintaining a proper bond

The firm was suspended from doing business until it obtains a proper bond.

The P&S Act is a fair trade practices law. It promotes and maintains fair and open competition in the buying and selling of livestock, meat and poultry

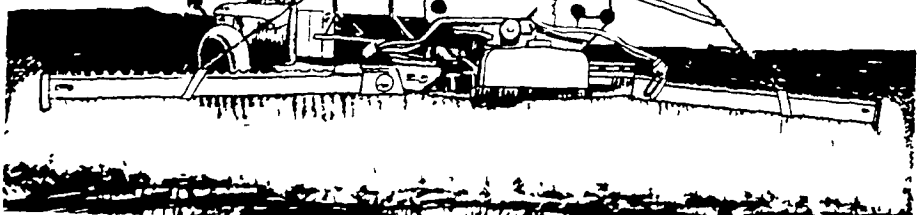
