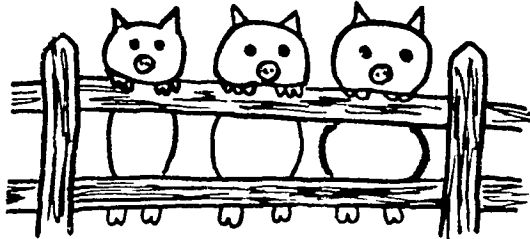
years. The money paid for the homes then goes into a special fund which will help pay the cost of drilling a well for the community. The people, in effect, are paying themselves and will have a community fund. Preston noted that homes currently under construction are reinforced block houses with the foundation being built two feet below the surface. Preston said, "You always see pictures and hear stories about places like this. But you don't understand it until you have the opportunity to witness it first hand and to walk into the houses and meet people. That brings it home." Sheryl added, "It seems unreal. Even there we were not sure we were really experiencing it. We are not quite as materialistic. It helped us realize we have so much here." Would they like to go again? Without hesitation both Sheryl and Preston agreed they would like to participate in another mission, although they realize it cannot be done soon again. They do hope their experience will serve as a stimulus to others who may have an interest. And Sheryl's incorporating her first hand experiences into a previously scheduled study unit in her classroom.

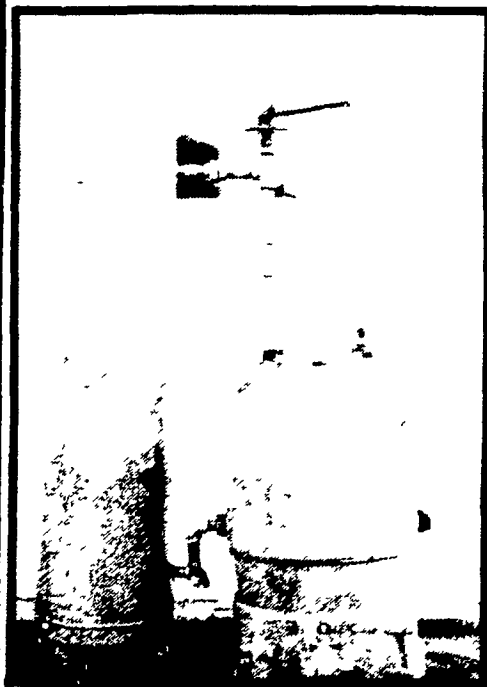

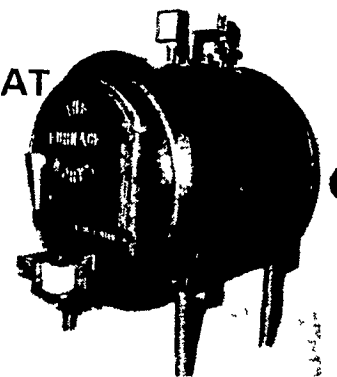

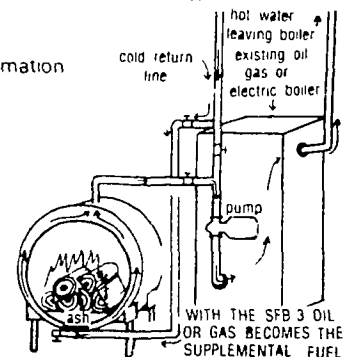

A Typical Installation

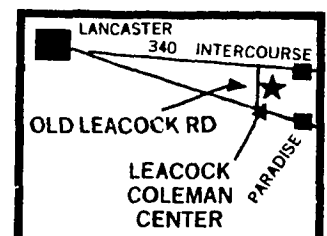
