## Fulton Grange sets April events

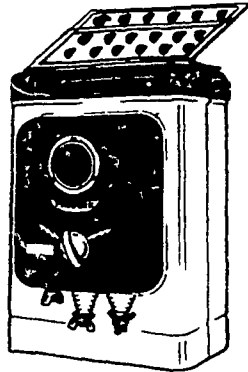
OAKRYN — Fulton Grange No. 66 lists the following coming events:

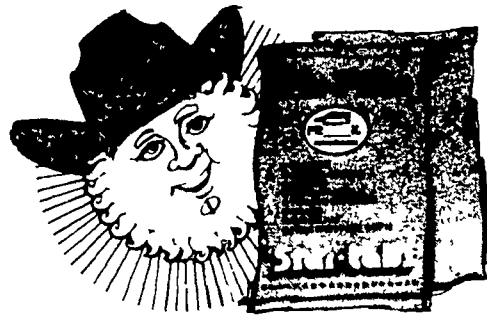

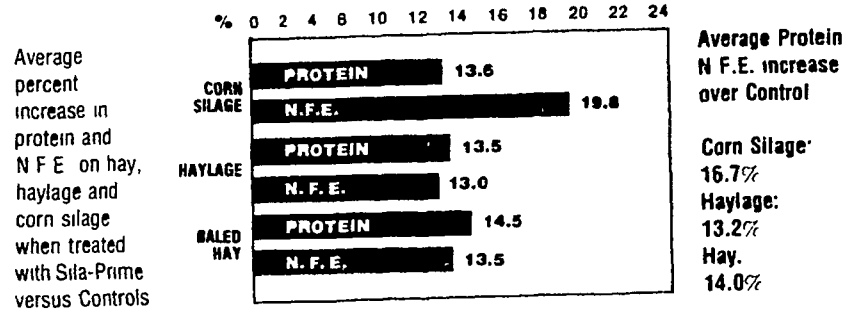
