FLEMINGTON, N.J. -Noted dairy cow sterility expert, Dr. James Evans, University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine, will speak to a group of area dairy farmers and 4-H youth on Friday evening, April 18, 8 p.m. at Hunterdon County's Extension Center, Flemington, N.J.

Dr. Evans is a Professor of Veterinary Medicine and heads up the Pennsylvania Embryo Transfer Service, a leader in the techniques involved in transfering embryos from outstanding brood cows to host animals,

Meeting is open to all persons interested in breeding dairy cattle, says Douglass. For more information call 201/782-4300, ext. 338.






