USDA announces sale of soybean contract rights

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Secretary of Agriculture Bob Bergland today said the Commodity Credit Corporation has assigned contract rights for 7.0 million bushels (191,280 metric tons) for U.S. no. 2 or better yellow soybeans.

The soybeans were acquired by CCC as a result of the suspension of exports to the Soviet Union.

Bergland said the weighted average prices on the successful bidders for the Gulf delivery were \$6.02 for April, \$6.12-1/4 for May and \$6.26-1/2 for June. The March 31 reported Chicago spot market price for U.S. no. 1 soybeans was \$5.67 per bushel.

These soybeans were scheduled for delivery f.o.b. shipment during April, May and June from Gulf and Great Lake ports. This makes a total of 13.4 million bushels (366,280 tons) of soybean contracts sold by CCC since the invitation for offers was made March 20.

The remaining quantities for April delivery on the next tender are 20,800 tons and 5480 tons, both f.o.b. Gulf.

Offers will continue to be received for soybeans on

Monday and Thursday of each week until the invitation is withdrawn, Bergland said. Successful offerers will be notified by 10:30 a.m. EST the day following the offer date. Public announcement will be made after the commodity markets close.

Offers are to be submitted to the deputy administrator for commodity operations, USDA-ASCS, room 218-W, Box 2415, Washington, D.C. 20013.
