Agee sentenced for meat scam

ANNAPOLIS — Walter F. Agee was convicted on Friday, April 11 for operating a bait and switch meat scheme in LaVale, Maryland.

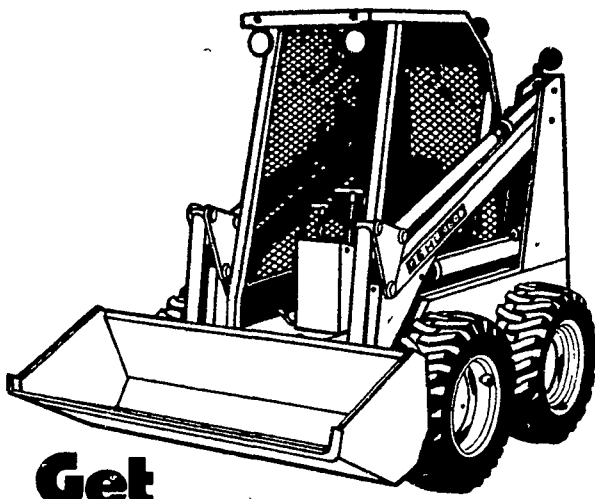
He was sentenced to a two year prison term and was fined \$5000 by Judge Getty.

According to Lacy DeGrange of the Maryland Department of Agriculture Weights and Measures, Agee pleaded guilty to nine counts involving the sale of inferior meat at the former LaVale Country Meat Store, located along the National Highway.

Agee was arrested last November when he opened another store, known as the Beef Quarter Meat Store in Roscoe, Pennsylvania.

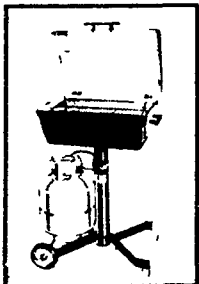
Agee, of Indian Head, Fayette County, was found by MDA's inspectors to have sold meat that contained maggots. His sales were also found to be less than the quantity and quality advertised, according to the state inspectors.

DeGrange added that it is not known at this time if the sentence will be appealed by Agee and his representative Attorney Tim Finan. SM
