Also these chapter officers awarded Honorary Chapter Degrees to their parents. Paul Snider and Ivan Niswander, who attended


Niswander, who attended the National FFA Convention in Kansas City, Kansas, presented a slide show of the Convention highlights.


Jeffrey Kerr, who serves as State Sentinel, addressed the group. Entertainment was


