## Farm Bureau pleased with \$3 billion

WASHINGTON, D.C. — "Farm Bureau is very pleased that the Federal Reserve Board has taken action to help relieve the credit crunch in rural areas," according to American Farm Bureau Federation President Robert B. Delano.

His reaction came from Friday's announcement by the Federal Reserve Board that it is making available to member banks up to \$3 billion to be used exclusively for loans to farmers and small businessmen.

The Fed's action said this will result in loans to farmers in the range of 15 to 18

Federal Reserve Board Vice-Chairman, Frederick H. Schultz, announced the plan before a House Small Subcommittee. Schultz said the Fed had determined that farmers and small businessmen were particularly hard-hit by high interest rates.

To qualify for the newly-available funds, banks must have a total assets of less than \$100-million and show a loan-to-deposit ratio of at least 68 percent.
