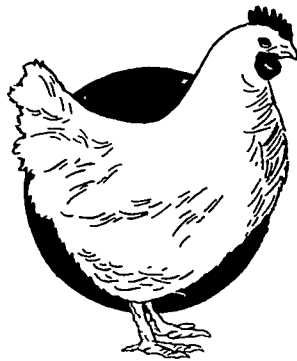
The group will also sponsor a Rocking-Chair-athon May 10-11, 10 a.m.-10 a.m. for a worthy cause.

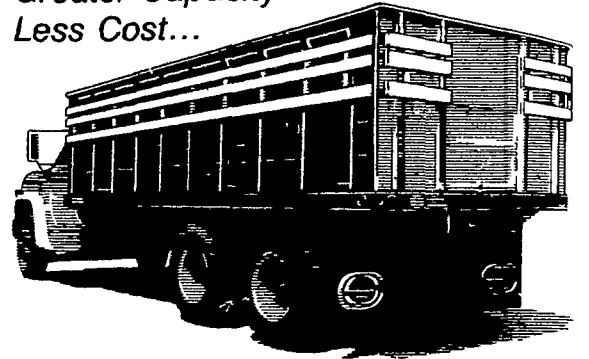
### York Co. Society 31

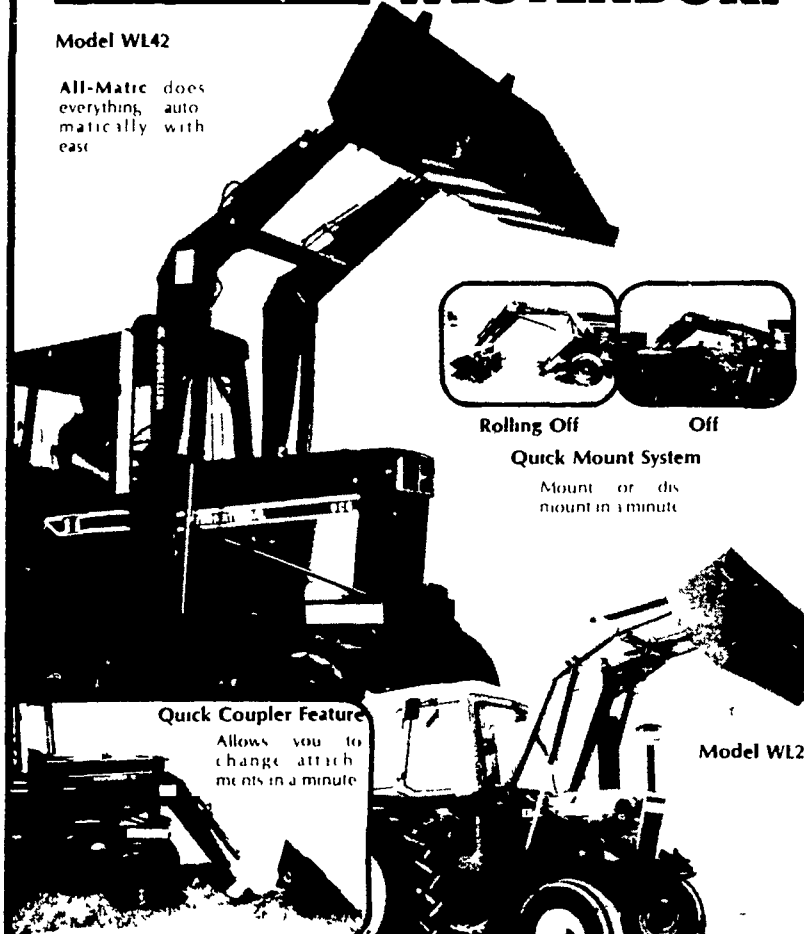
