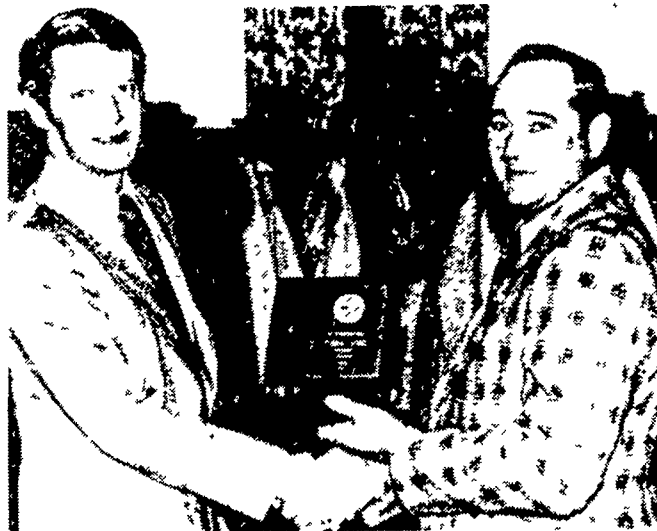
more government regulations."

The next meeting will be held May 19 at the home of Jim Stauffer. Jim, a Suffolk breeder, lives on Weaver Road, west of Lancaster.









The program for the May meeting will be a demonstration by Barbara Herr on Shearing and Worming.
