# Ag structure study finished, new ag act to begin

WASHINGTON, D.C. - At exists today. It is hoped that the study and the report will provide basic background information for the 1981 farm bill. As Chairman Talmadge states in the foreward. "This publication marks the beginning of the committee's task of writing that bill."


