To be eligible for the award, a DHIA supervisor must have one full year's service as of January 1 of the year for which the award was made. He must be a fulltime supervisor and he must keep up with DHIA work.

Testers must attend two of three conferences held during the year, have an average mailing time of not over 2.9 days, have less than three percent of his herds tested outside the centering day range for the testing year, and have fewer than 10 percent errors on the monthly report.

The award, plus \$10 is

presented annually at the Spring District DHIA supervisor conference.

Further monetary awards are made thereafter for each five consecutive years a supervisor receives the Merit Award. They range from \$25 for five consecutive years service to \$100 for 20 consecutive years and

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
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

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
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
