## Angus Juniors elect delegates

ST. JOSEPH, Mo. — Young Angus enthusiasts nation-wide are electing delegates and candidates to travel to Wichita, Kansas, this July to represent their home states as they join forces to establish the

National Junior Angus Association, reports Jerry Lipsey, American Angus Association junior activities director.

Each state can choose one candidate for tenure on a 12-member national board of

directors that will represent more than 12,000 young American Angus Association junior and life members and nearly 70 state and local junior Angus associations.

Directors will be elected by state delegates. Each state can have two official voting delegates. The newly elected national directors will elect officers from the board members.

Any life or junior member of the American Angus Association less than 21 years of age January 1, 1980, is eligible to be a candidate. Board members will serve two-year terms with six new people elected to the board each year. This year, however, one-year terms will be randomly assigned to six directors, and six will serve for two years.

The national association's goals will include personal development of outstanding juniors through new challenges, goals and

rewards; improvements of state and local organizations through improved leadership of junior officers and directors; increased youth input for organization and direction of junior activities; challenging national organizations to promote and improve Angus; and encouraging all junior members and livestock youth to develop their potential in agriculture and in life.

This organizational meeting will be featured in conjunction with the 12th National Junior Angus Heifer Show and the 14th National Angus Showmanship Contest. The four-day event will be staged July 18-21 at the Kansas Coliseum and Livestock Facility in Wichita, and is sponsored by the Kansas Junior Angus Association, Kansas Angus Association and American Angus Association.

## Whey grade standards revised

WASHINGTON — The USDA has revised the U.S. grade standards for dry whey to include whey of higher acidity than was previously eligible for grading under the standards.

Carol Tucker Foreman, assistant secretary for food and consumer services, said the changes were made because the number of uses for dry whey as a food ingredient has increased in

recent years, and official standards will help to assure uniformity in the product.

Foreman said dry whey is increasingly sought after by the food industry because it is a good source of calcium, potassium, zinc, high quality protein and other minerals and vitamins. Dry whey also contains all of the 10 essential amino acids necessary for proper nutrition, she said.

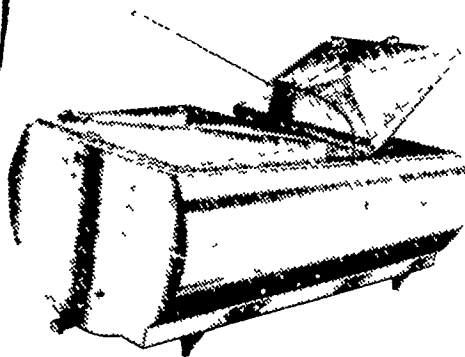
