The team from Lehigh County had a score that ranked second to the top team. Western Montgomery came in third, with Upper




The first place team at the Southeast Area Livestock Judging Contest was the Philadelphia Chapter FFA, left to right, Allan Downing; Brian

program. The next meeting will be Tuesday, May 27 at 7:30 p.m. at the 4-H Center. Reported by Beverly Eisenhart.



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
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
