April, 1980

The herd of W B Saul High School had the highest daily butterfat average. This Holstein herd of 14 cows averaged 54.1 pounds of milk, 2.29 pounds of butterfat with a 4.2 percent test.

The herd of Merrill G Ruth placed second. This Holstein herd of 59.5 cows averaged 60.3 pounds of milk, 2.06 pounds of butterfat with a 3.4 percent test.

Noted among 305 day lactations were Susan owned by Richard A Bechtel, producing 19,967 pounds of milk and

818 pounds of butterfat. Carol owned by Gordon Moser, producing 17,934 pounds of milk and 767 pounds of butterfat, Pearl Of Du Mar Farm, producing 20,811 pounds of milk and 665 pounds of butterfat, cow #148 owned by Maynard Rothenberger, producing 20,388 pounds of milk and 693 pounds of butterfat, and cow #613 of Hy-Vue Farms, producing 24,172 pounds of milk and 801 pounds of butterfat.
