

Berks County DHIA Monthly Report

March, 1980

The herd of Charles and Tim Kissing, R2 Robesonia, had the highest daily butterfat average. This Holstein herd of 629 cows averaged 72.6 pounds of milk, 2.46 pounds of butterfat with a 3.4 percent test.

The herd of Heindel Farms, Inc. placed second. This Holstein herd of 271 cows averaged 61.1 pounds of milk, 2.45 pounds of butterfat with a 4.0 test.

Among top 305-day lactations were those two cows owned by Andrew D. Stoltzfus. Connie produced 24,244 pounds of milk and 906 pounds of butterfat, while Agnes produced 23,138 pounds of milk and 966 pounds of butterfat. Also, Mitzi

of Vista Grande Farm produced 24,966 pounds of milk and 850 pounds of butterfat.

Berks County herds averaging 1.5 pounds of butterfat or over include:

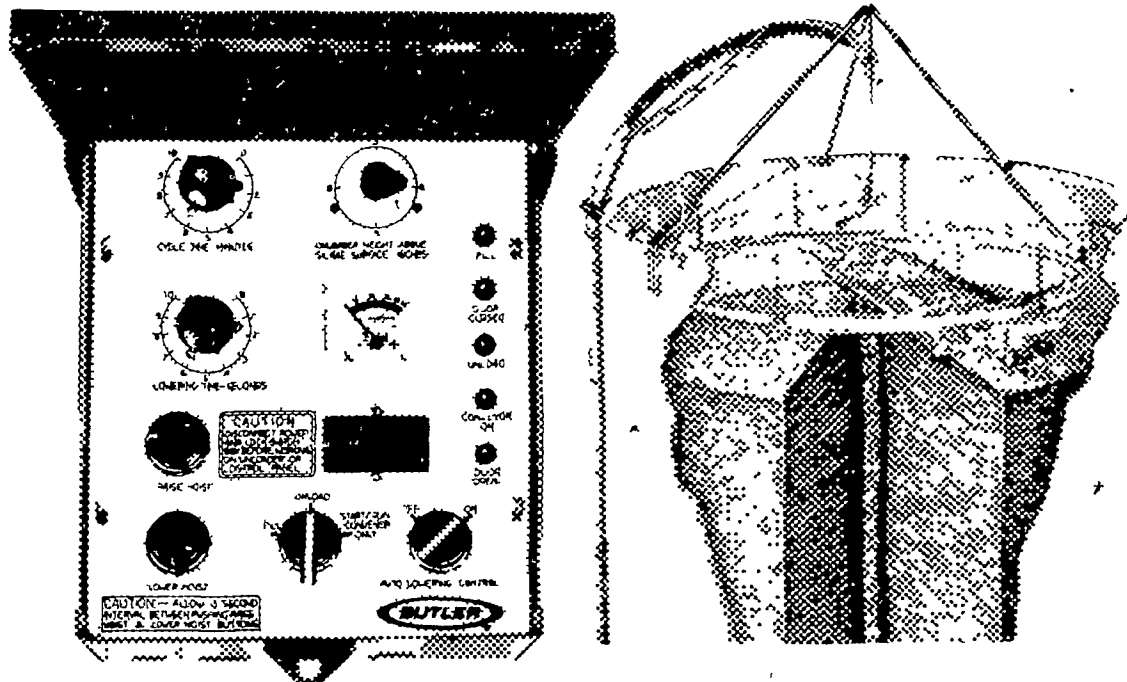

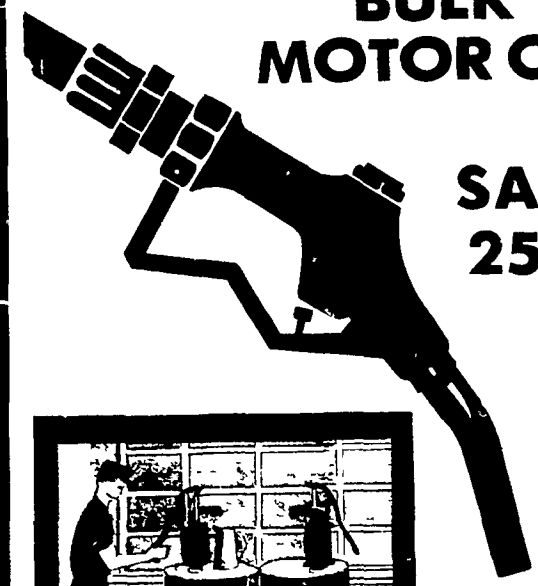
