There is a brother Enos Diller McIntyre and he feels two from one family is enough in the war In his letter dated April 6, 1864 he stresses to his mother that he doesn't drink whiskey and that he has plenty of soft bread and fresh beef to eat.

There is also a newspaper clipping with the letters which states that William Weidler McIntyre died Feb. 16, 1876 aged 15 years, 5 months and 12 days.

Considering the present unrest in our world, such letters certainly give us reason to pause and pray for


