

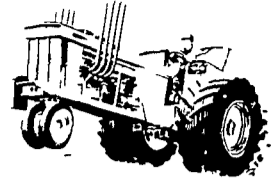

Resource inventory underway in Dauphin

HARRISBURG — A natural resource inventory is presently underway in Dauphin County, announced Joel Myers, District Conservationist for the Soil

Conservation Service in Dauphin County. This inventory includes the evaluation of present land use as it relates to the loss of valuable topsoil, he said.

Specific items being taken into consideration are stream bank erosion, erosion on construction sites, the loss of soil on farm land, timber potential and the evaluation of wildlife habitat.

This broad base inventory is one of the first to be undertaken in Pennsylvania. The study is jointly sponsored by the Dauphin County Conservation District and SCS in cooperation with Penn State. Information for the evaluation of land use and our natural resources is being taken from approximately 300 locations in Dauphin County. Each of these locations includes a 107

acre block and 3 specific locations within each block.

To eliminate any bias in the selection of locations, a computer program designed by the Iowa State University was used to determine all inventory sites.

The study when completed will provide detailed county information. This resource information will be made available to numerous agencies involved with conservation and land use within Dauphin County. It will provide a sound basis from which to direct conservation and natural resource related programs, said Myers.

Field work for the inventory is presently underway and will be completed by September, Myers added. Initial results of the study are expected to be completed early in 1981.
