859-1331**Senate ag committee extends FIFRA funding**

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Forestry last Wednesday approved legislation in S Agriculture, Nutrition and 2587 authorizing continued

funding of the Federal pesticide regulatory program for fiscal year 1981.

The Committee approved a spending level of \$77.5 million for the year beginning Oct. 1 to carry out the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) under the Environmental Protection Agency. The authorization includes \$13 million for research, development and related activities.

Other bills approved by the Committee Wednesday include:

H.R. 6285 to amend the Egg Research and Consumer Information Act to increase the size of the American Egg Board, to require that consumers be represented on the board, and to increase the assessment on egg producers to carry out the egg information program.

S 1625 to provide for the



adjustment or cancellation of USDA claims against a small number of farmers arising from the administration of the hay transportation assistance program.

S 2043 to provide for coordination between the Department of Agriculture and the National Institutes of Health in the conduct of basic research on cancer in animals and birds.
