

Farm news service to begin on TV

LITITZ — Farm and agricultural news will be a regular early-morning part of the live, twenty-four-hour-a-day news coverage of the Cable News Network when CNN begins to be offered to U.S. cable systems following CNN's premiere Sunday, June 1 at 6 p.m. Eastern Time.

CNN promises by the immediacy and the thoroughness of its coverage to change the way in which Americans are informed about domestic and global events and issues.

From the moment it is launched, CNN will present continuous news and possess an unprecedented capability to "go live" anywhere in the world where major news is breaking, and to do follow-up pieces at any hour of the day or night.

Beyond its hard-news capabilities, CNN will offer a wide variety of special features, human interest stories, celebrity interviews, talk programs and consumer reports.

CNN's Farm Reporter John Holliman, Jr., who has

been Associated Press Radio's agricultural reporter for the past six years, will produce and report CNN's farm and agricultural news.

During the early morning hours, Holliman will present brief reports of farm news and weather at regular intervals. Following his early morning farm segments, Holliman will cover, each day, stories of interest to farmers and consumers; stories about such topics as price support hearings, farm protests or consumer protests, grain embargos and grain surpluses, pesticides and herbicides, and the food and drug issues.

His reports on these events will be included in newscasts throughout the day

"The economy is the big story of the decade," said Holliman, "and CNN's coverage will strive to make clear the connection between farmers and consumers. Problems affecting farmers inevitably will affect consumers' pocketbooks, and CNN will have the time and

resources to explore this crucial relationship fully."

CNN's farm and agricultural coverage will include breaking news stories, farm weather reporting and forecasting, current farm prices, in-depth interviews and influential agricultural leaders and policy-makers,

and feature material from around the country that explores different aspects of the American agricultural scene.

Holliman will operate from CNN's Washington bureau, which will be staffed by seventy-five electronic journalists, executives, and technical persons.
