

# Lancaster Conservation District schedules farm tours

LANCASTER — The Lancaster County Conservation District will sponsor a bus tour of farms and industries on June 10, 1980 which will show a variety of conservation practices.

The tour will start at 8:30 a.m. from the Farm and Home Center parking lot, 1383 Arcadia Road.

The first stop will be at the new Willow Valley Shopping Center where the storm water management system will be pointed out. Also, those desiring to join the tour at this point will be picked up at 8:45 a.m. at the gravel parking lot on the west side of Route 222 just north of the entrance to the Willow Valley Restaurant

The second stop will be the Steunman Farm, which won the 1979 Regional Maurice K. Goddard Forestry Award. Foresters will discuss forest management practices and marketing and harvesting of timber.

Next stop will be Philadelphia Electric's Muddy Run Pump Storage Hydro-Electric Plant. Here, the group will tour the power plant to see how the pump-storage electric generating system operates. Also, a special presentation on the potential shad fishery of the Susquehanna River and the steps Philadelphia Electric will take in the future at the Conowingo Dam will be shown.

After a chicken barbecue

lunch at Muddy Run, the tour will visit Bob Kauffman's farm, along Prowl's Hollow Road. Kauffman was selected as the 1980 Conservation Cooperator. Featured at the Kauffman

farm will be the manure management system which separates solids from liquids by means of a "picket fence".

A number of other farms will be viewed by the tour

that have installed pipe outlet terraces, waterways, and contour strips.

The cost for the tour and lunch will be \$5. Reservations can be made by calling the Lancaster County

A Junior and Senior Fitting and Showmanship contest will take place at 2:30. Classes will be divided

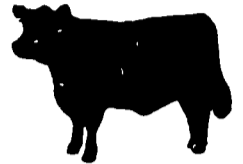
into two divisions: Junior class, ages 9-14 and Senior class, ages 15-21. Awards will be given for each division winner and the overall winner.
