RAISIN CREME PIE

1 cup raisins, cooked and drained

1¼ cups milk

2 egg yolks ⅔ cup sugar

2 tablespoons flour

1 tablespoon butter

pinch of salt

1 teaspoon vanilla

Bring the milk to a boiling point. Take dry ingredients and mix with enough milk to make a smooth batter. Add egg yolks and beat until smooth. Add to boiling milk, stirring until thickened. Remove from heat and add butter, raisins, and vanilla. Pour into baked pie crust and top with whipped cream or meringue when cold.

GOURMET POTATOES

6 medium potatoes 1/4 cup butter 1½ cups sour cream 1 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon pepper 2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese ⅓ cup finely chopped onion 2 tablespoons butter paprika

Cook potatoes in skins. Cool. Peel and chop finely. In a saucepan over low heat, combine cheese and ¼ cup butter. Stir until melted.

Remove from heat and blend in sour cream, onion and seasonings. Fold in the potatoes and turn into a greased 2 quart casserole dish. Dot with butter and sprinkle with paprika. Bake uncovered at 350° F. for 30 minutes or until heated through. Serves 8.

APPLE ROQUEFORT POTATO SALAD

6 medium potatoes 3 cup lemon juice

3 tablespoons oil

2 teaspoons salt

½ cup mayonnaise 1/4 cup dairy sour cream

2 tablespoons light cream

1 large red apple, quartered, cored and thinly sliced ¼-½ cup crumbled Roquefort cheese

Cook potatoes until tender. Peel and cut into thin slices. Place in a large bowl. Combine lemon juice, oil, and salt in a jar with a screw top. Cover and shake well. Pour over slices and toss to coat. Cover and chill 3 hours. Just before serving, combine mayonnaise, sour cream, and light cream in a small bowl until smooth. Pour over potatoes and toss well. Add apple slices and cheese. Toss lightly. Line a salad bowl with lettuce and spoon salad into bowl. Garnish with slices of apple.


