

South Americans join to sell ag produce

BUENOS AIRES — producers, are planning Argentina and Australia, bilateral cooperation to improve their competitive two of the world's top grain

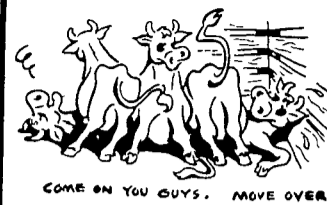
