a high quality product. Kimble says the importance of growth is obvious. Increased growth rate means a shorter feeding period. Faster gaining sheep normally convert feed more efficiently.

However, we need to also be concerned about the composition of this growth. Seventy-five to eighty-five percent of the differences observed in the retail yield of differences in fat trim. It is therefore important to know if the gain is in the form of fat or muscle.


