enough soybeans to meet the world demand.

"We expect continued growth in the developed markets," Bader says. "Even a five percent annual increase in the top 10 markets means additional use of about 36 million bushels or the amount of

soybeans produced from approximately 1.2 million acres.

"In addition, we believe that our expanded market development activities in the developing markets should increase their soy consumption. We anticipate continued growth in Eastern

Europe, Latin America and Southeast Asia, plus real potential increases in China.

"The decade of the 80s will see tremendous growth in the worldwide demand for U.S. produced soybeans. And soybean farmers, economically hard pressed today, can look with considerable hope toward profitable production once again."
