testing of imported horses for equine piroplasmosis.

The department's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service had published a notice in the April 27, 1979, Federal Register proposing that EP testing be dropped. Much controversy has been expressed relative to the pros and cons of such action.

Therefore, before any final action is taken, a panel will be selected to hold a public meeting on the proposal. The objective of the meeting is to obtain more information relative to the seriousness of the disease and the impacts of removing the test requirement from the regulation.

According to Francis J. Mulhern, APHIS ad-ministrator, the department is particularly interested in receiving information from

scientific experts, who have had firsthand experience with the disease, both in the U.S. and abroad.

Equine piroplasmosis is caused by a tick-born microscopie parasite that destroys red blood cells. Although the disease is rarely fatal and some infected horses may never show symptoms, it can weaken horses through anemia and liver damage.

The members of the panel will be announced in a future issue of the Federal Register together with the date and place for the public meetings.
