There are 47 head of cows, including 1st and 2nd calf heifers. All home raised - calfhood vaccinated. T.B. & Blood tested within 30 days. Last winter this dairyman shipped a ton of milk a day. For the month of May he was shipping 3900 lbs. every two days. Creamery test 3.8-3.9. Herd was sold due to illness of owner. This is a good uddered herd and was never pushed for high production.
