

Seniors consider a class of breeding ewes at Erdenheim farms.


Southern York County as a fitting and showmanship techniques of beef cattle and explained how a European breed, Simmental, is being used to upgrade the quality of calves in their beef herd.

The second stop was Airville Farm Service where the business and mechanical end of York County agriculture was discussed.

Greg Innerst's swine breeding operation, located just outside of Red Lion, was the site of the next visit. Innerst explained his swine breeding program where he registered raises Berkshire's and Duroc's.

During a stop at Beth Holtzinger's farm, Rossi was introduced to freeze branding cattle. Holtzinger plans to exhibit her steers at the Farm Show and all steers to be shown at the Pennsylvania State Farm Show in January must be identified by freeze branding before June 1. He also saw some of the 55 acres of tomatoes the Holtzinger's plant and learned about cultural practices in growing tomatoes.

Brvan Workinger showed how replacement calves are cared for. And Kevin Holtzinger explained his farming operation which milks 120 cows in a milking parlor and farms over 300 acres of land.
