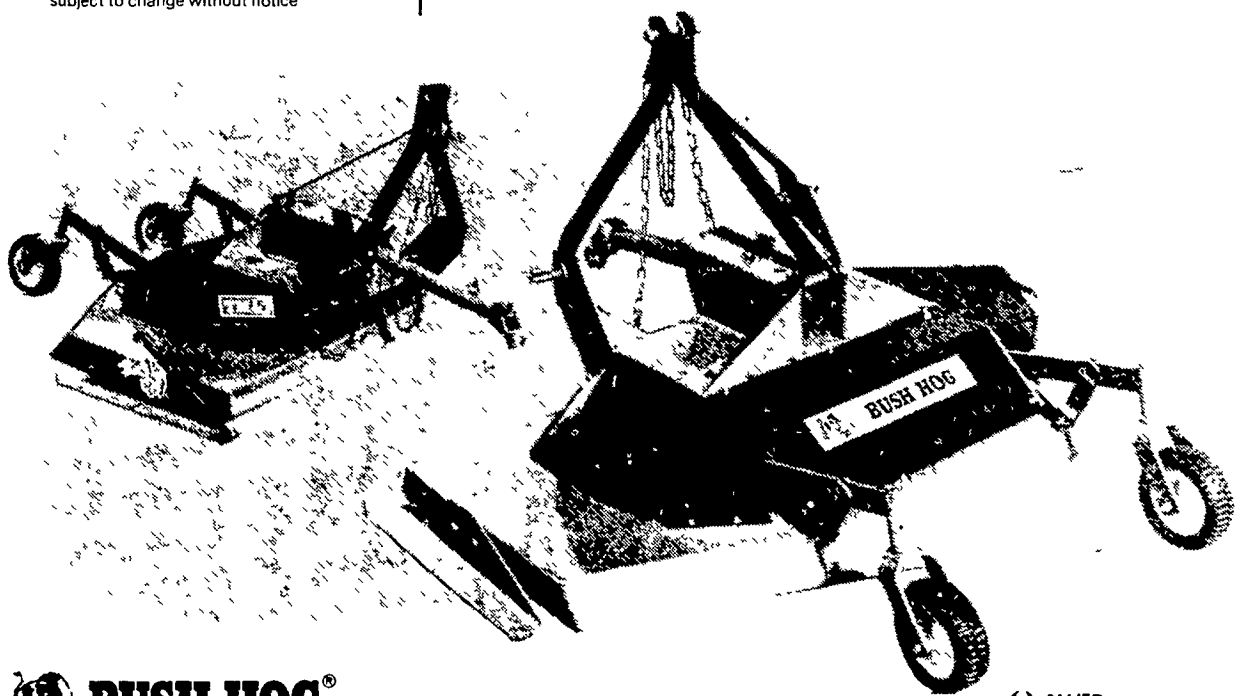

Belting on the TM-5 is in-line — to eliminate annoying twists, jumping out of place. This special belting is rated up to 2600 hours of life, with extreme resistance to stretching and tearing.

#### Fast Assembly, Fully Shielded

Assembly of the TM-5 is fast, simple. A new spindle housing design allows individual bearings to be replaced if necessary, rather than the complete housing assembly. Cutter blades are enclosed by the base frame, and the TM-5 is fully shielded for operator protection. A shear pin on the driveline is standard equipment.
