

Lancaster County DHIA Monthly Report

LANCASTER COUNTY DHIA May 1980

Two cows tied for first place this month. A Registered Holstein cow owned by Ken and Nelson Stoner, 196 W. Lexington Rd., Lititz, #81 produced 26,004 pounds of milk, 1036 pounds of butterfat with a 4.0 percent test in 305 days.

A Registered Holstein cow owned by Nelson W. Nolt, R2, Peach Bottom, #16 produced 21,987 pounds of milk, 1036 pounds of butterfat with a 4.7 percent test in 305 days.

The herd of Paul H. Martin, R1, Ephrata, had the highest daily butterfat average. This herd of 374 Registered Holstein cows averaged 60.7 pounds of milk, 2.37 pounds of butterfat with a 3.9 percent test.

The herd of Adam and Jerene Zimmerman, R1, East Earl, placed second.

This herd of 259 Registered and grade Holstein cows averaged 69.8 pounds of milk, 2.29 pounds of butterfat with a 3.3 percent test.
