Early in life Hoelper developed a keen interest in dairying. He has worked with four outstanding dairy farmers to learn and gain experience with the various operations.

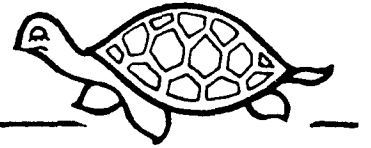
Hoelper recently graduated from Delaware Valley College in

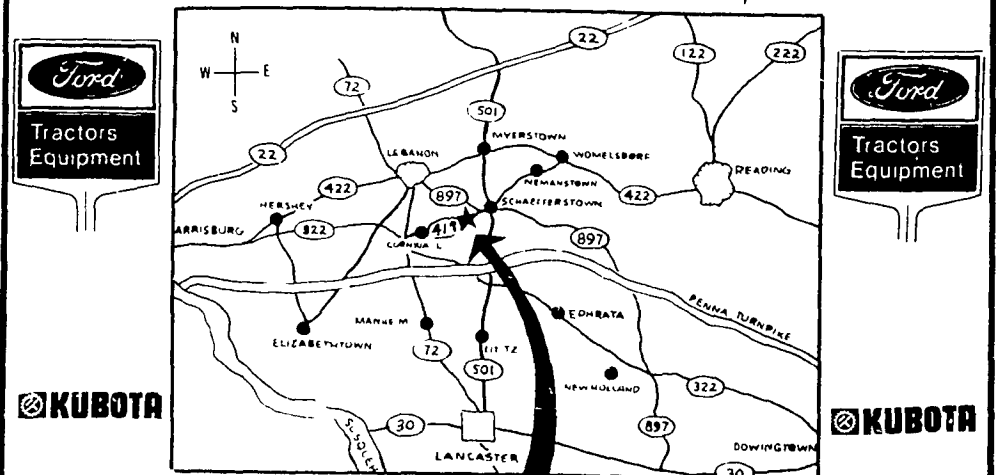

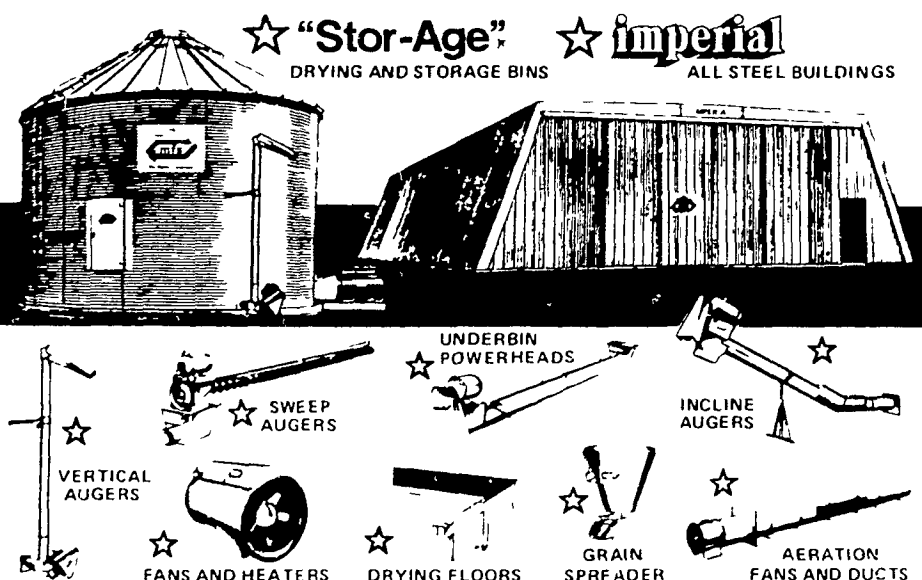
