OATMEAL DROP COOKIES

1 cup shortening

1½ cups sugar

2 eggs

13/4 cups flour ½ teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon baking powder

1 teaspoon soda

2 cups rolled oats

1 teaspoon cunnamon

½ cup sour milk 1 cup chopped raisins or dates

½ cup chopped nuts

Cream shortening and sugar together. Add eggs and beat until fluffy. Sift flour. Measure and add salt, soda, baking powder and cinnamon. Sift again. Add rolled oats and mix thoroughly. Add dry ingredients alternately with milk to creamed mixture. Mix thoroughly. Fold in chopped raisins or dates and nuts and stir until well blended. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto greased baking sheet, spaced 2-3 inches apart. Flatten with a fork. Bake at 350° F. for 12-15 minutes. Makes 6 dozen cookies.

SUGAR COOKIES

1 cup shortening

2 cups sugar, granulated, or light brown

2 eggs

5 cups flour

1 teaspoon salt

11/2 teaspoons baking powder

1 teaspoon soda 4 cup milk

1 teaspoon vanılla

Cream shortening and sugar together. Add flavoring. Use half butter for good flavor. Add eggs and beat until fluffy. Sift flour. Measure and add salt, soda and baking powder. Sift again and add sifted dry ingredients alternately with milk. Stir until dough is smooth Chill in refrigerator for several hours. Roll out to 4 inch thickness and cut into fancy shapes. Place 1 inch apart on a greased cookie sheet and bake at 400° F. for 8-10 minutes. Makes about 6 dozen cookies.




