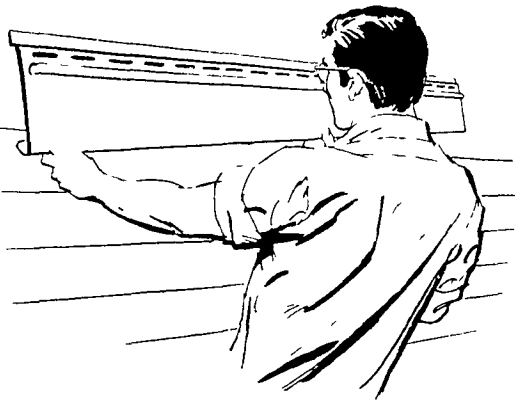

## WHOLE WHEAT PANCAKES

- 2 eggs
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon butter
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 cup milk
- 2 cups whole wheat flour

Beat eggs, add sugar and milk. Sift dry ingredients together and add to liquid. Add melted shortening and blend together. Bake on hot griddle. Makes 8-10 cakes.

## BALLOON BUNS

- 1 package dried yeast
- ¼ cup warm water
- ¾ cup luke warm milk
- ¼ cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 well-beaten egg
- ¼ cup shortening
- 3½-3¾ cups flour
- 1 tablespoon cinnamon
- 1 cup sugar
- ½ cup butter
- 24 large marshmallows

Dissolve the yeast in the warm water. Mix the yeast, milk, sugar, salt, egg, shortening and flour. Mix thoroughly and let rise 1 hour. In a small bowl mix the cinnamon, sugar and butter. Put the cinnamon mixture around each marshmallow. Roll the dough when risen around the marshmallows and place in cake pans. Bake at 350° F. for 25-30 minutes.

## LEMON PUDDING CAKE

- 4 eggs, separated
- ½ cup lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon grated lemon rind
- 1 tablespoon melted butter or margarine
- ¾ cup sugar
- ½ cup flour
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 1½ cups milk

Beat egg whites until stiff and set aside. In another bowl, beat together the egg yolks, lemon juice, lemon rind, and butter until thick and lemon-colored. Combine sugar, flour and salt. Add dry ingredients alternately with milk, beating well. Blend beaten egg whites into this mixture. Pour into 8-inch square baking dish. Bake at 350° F. for 40 minutes or until golden brown. Cut into squares. Serve warm or cold.

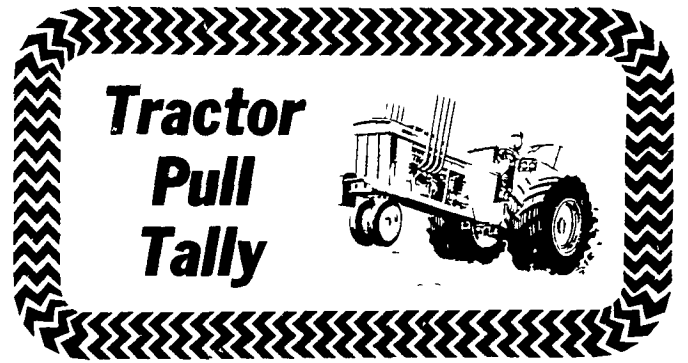


## BUTTERSCOTCH OATMEAL
