

## Inter-State's Gartley dies

COCHRANVILLE - Boyd C. Gartley, director of member relations for Inter-State Milk Producers' Cooperative, died unexpectedly Saturday morning, June 21.

Gartley, in addition to his activities as director of the Co-op's member relations activities, also handled Inter-State's public relations duties.

He was associate editor of the "Pennmarva" news magazine, published for members of the Pennmarva Dairymen's Federation. That group includes Inter-State, Maryland and Virginia Milk Producers Association, Maryland Cooperative Milk Producers, and Capitol Milk Producers Cooperative.

Gartley's death was attributed to a heart attack.

A memorial service is scheduled at the Cochranville Methodist Church for Sunday, June 29 at 3 p.m. The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon at the same church.

Gartley resided with his wife in Cochranville. The family mailing address is


