

York plans July 1 ag field day

DOVER — The Dover Area Young Farmers and York's ag extension service are teaming up to sponsor a county-wide agriculture field day on Tuesday, July 1.

Three farms west of Dover will host visitors to the variety of field trials and demonstrations. From the Charles Rauhauser farm, farm wagons will haul visitors to other plots at the Clair Myers and Mike Hoffman operations. An

afternoon session will run from 1 to 4 p.m. and the evening program begins at 7 p.m. through dark.

Included in the field displays are herbicide trials in conventional and no-tilled corn and alfalfa, corn and alfalfa varieties, various application rates of Furadan in corn stands and Furadan 4-flowable in new alfalfa plots.

Demonstrations are also

planned covering the use of insect nets in determining alfalfa leaf hopper infestations and proper mixing techniques for herbicides.

Nearly two dozen seed, chemical and equipment firms have signed-up displays and will have representatives on hand to answer questions. A series of speakers are also scheduled on corn and alfalfa production and on herbicide

use.

Tour participants should take Route 74 to the Davidsburg Road, one and one-half miles south of Dover. Turn on Davidsburg

Road and travel to Admire Road. Turn left and follow the signs to the Rauhauser farm, a mile and a half beyond on Admire Road — JB

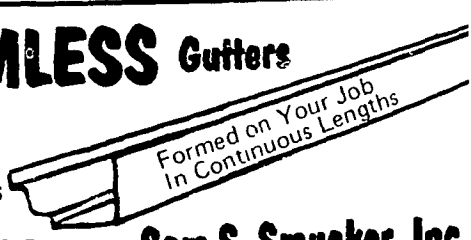

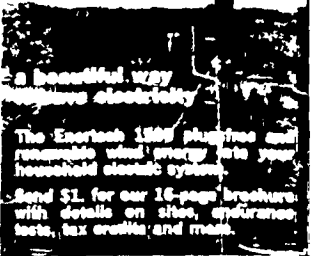
