Junior member, Cathy Myers, gave a demonstration on warbles in a horse. She told how this parasite will dig under the horse's skin and then live there for a period of time. A warble fly which came from her horse was passed around for the members to inspect.

Cathy then showed the 4-Hers a lump on her horse where a warble fly is presently living.

Another main topic discussed was the Lancaster County 4-H Roundup to be held Saturday, July 19 at the Lower Hopewell Horse Center. The Roundup provides an opportunity for all members of 4-H horse and pony clubs in Lancaster County to participate in a horse show. The top three winners of each class qualify for district competition.

The next Boots and Saddles meeting will be held on Friday, July 11 at 7:30 p.m. at the home of club member Pam Sammons, Neffsville.
