Peter R Beckjord, assistant professor of forestry at the University of Maryland, poses with 10-year-old Paulownia tree on the College park campus. Huge, heart-shaped leaf which he is holding came from a self-sown seedling nearby. It measures nearly 15 inches in both length and width Long considered a weed tree in the U.S., the

Paulownia has suddenly become valuable as an export commodity to Japan. Because of rapid growth, it also offers potential as a cash crop in the U.S. A biomass ingredient for gasohol could be one of its major uses. Like the hybrid poplar its fast growth would give it the quick turnover needed to produce a lot of wood quickly.
