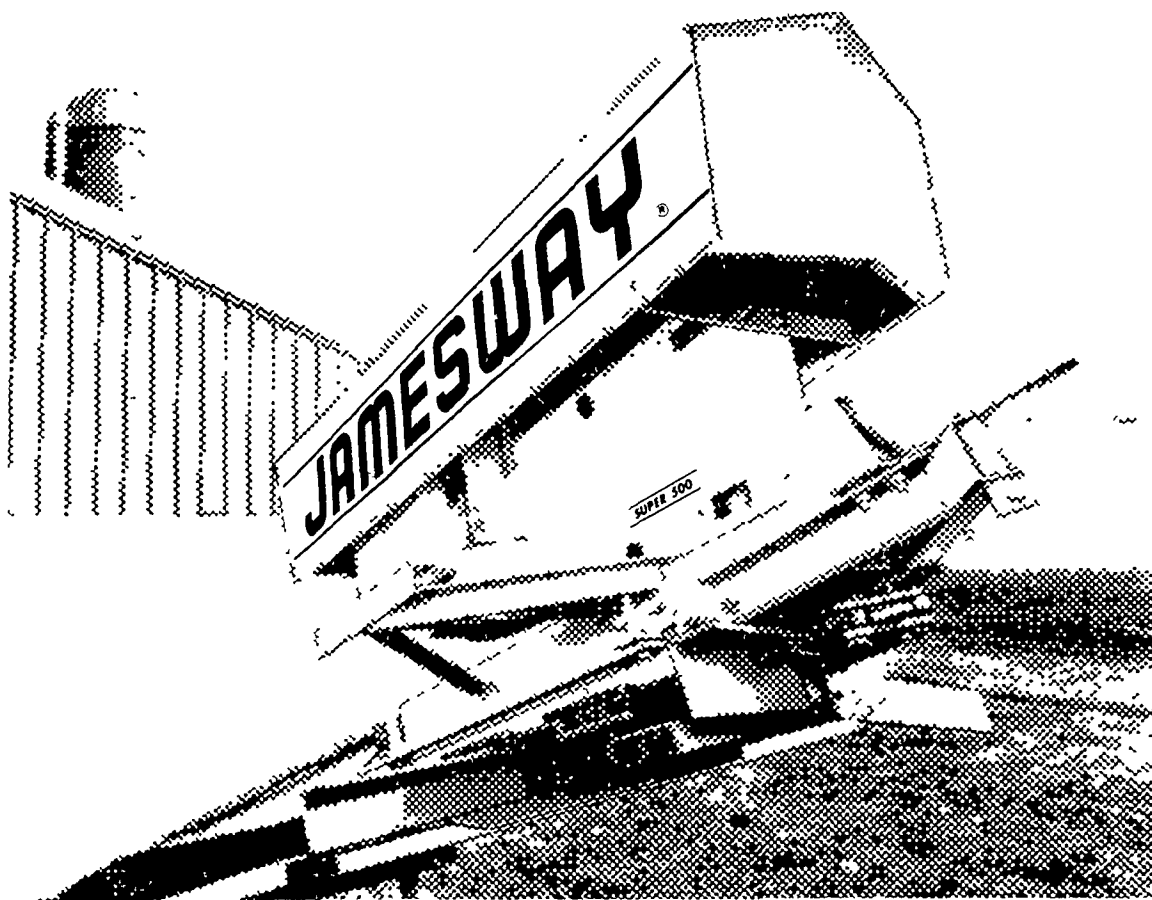
introduced her parents and, after a short interview, selected a question from a bowl. Miss Harnish's question was "Who or What is the greatest influence in your life?"
