In the ladies' division Robin Zell, R2 Elizabethtown took first place. Second place went to Ann Kopp, R1 Middletown; third, to Barb Kopp, Ann's sister-in-law

Teenage division title, 13 to 19 years old, went to Gerald Lehman, R2 Elizabethtown, second, Bruce Sine, Elizabethtown; third, Randy Oellig, R1 Grantville

went to Mike Zell, Robin Zell's husband In second place was Park Sheesley, Harrisburg, third place went to Karl Hertzler, Elizabethtown

Following the judging, Ronald Buffington outlined his ideas for breeding better Holsteins

Buffington said he feels farmers who use artificial insemination on cows and run a bull with heifers are missing a good chance to improve their herd quickly.

He said farmers should put their herds on a 100 percent AI program if they are going to realize maximum genetic growth.




