Rose control funds boosted

LEESPORT — Mark S Balthaser, chairman of the Berks County Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Committee, announced that additional funds have been made available for multiflora rose control under the 1980 Agricultural Conservation Program.

Although the original

county allocation of ACP funds were all approved for Berks County farmers months ago, cancellations and underspending have released some funds to be recommitted. "We are therefore taking a limited amount of 1980 ACP requests now for multiflora rose and other ACP practices," Balthaser said.

For 1980, multiflora rose control ACP benefits are 50 percent of the cost of the chemicals not to exceed \$25 per acre, he said adding special Tordon 10K training classes are no longer needed.

"All that is required is a private applicators certification. If you do not have a certification, course No. 181 is available through your Cooperation Extension Office for \$6 and an open book test can be taken," said Balthaser. If you need to be recertified, there will be a class at 2 p.m. and 7:30

p.m. on July 28, 1980 at the Berks County Ag Center, R.1, Leesport, conducted by the Cooperative Extension Service."

Materials such as Roundup and Banvel that will do the job controlling multiflora rose and no certification is required, Balthaser added.

Applications for cost-share help from ASCS are being taken at the county office in the Ag center in Bern Township. The next Berks County ASC Committee meeting, when action will be taken on applications received, will be Monday, July 21, 1980.
