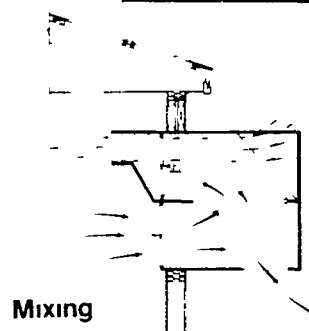
Why The 'Martin-air' System is best for you

Martin air units use an exclusive damper system which mixes fresh air and exhaust air so the output of the unit is never more than 4°F different from the room temperature. And, at any given spot in a properly designed barn, the temperature should seldom vary more than 1°.

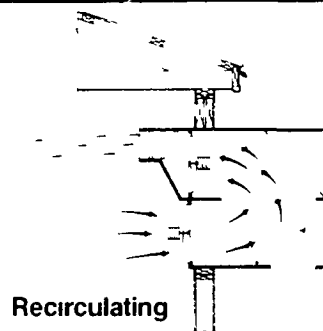
The Martin-air principle is simple and effective. Thermostats control fan speed and a dampered mixing chamber to blend fresh air with warm air. Constant circulation throughout the building maintains uniform temperature, eliminates drafts and reduces condensation to provide a dry environment.

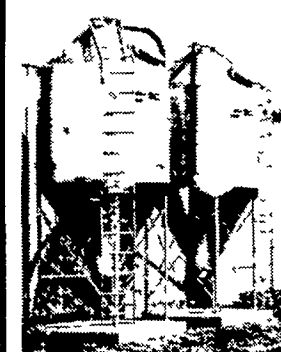
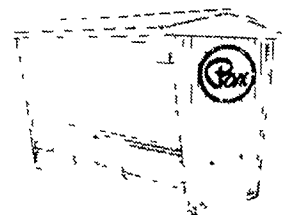
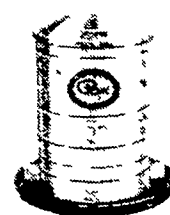
