## Corn plots being studied

ELVERSON — Farmers will have the opportunity to compare top field corn varieties growing side-by-side in the Twin Valley FFA field corn test plots. This plot is located north of Rt. 23 on Twin Valley Road on the farm of Calvin Kurtz.

The plot is planted in cooperation with local seed corn dealers, who supplied seed for the 30 varieties, and nine bushels of seed to distribute to students with field corn projects.

The public is invited to stop and inspect the plot. Additional information on it may be obtained from the vo-ag department at the Twin Valley High School. The field corn test plot committee, Tim Kurtz, Don

Chapter members will observe the 30 varieties as they grow this summer. In fall yield checks will be taken on each variety with comparisons made on yields, populations, standability, average ear weight, and percentage of moisture.
