

## Meat, poultry committee to meet July 29, 30

WASHINGTON, D.C. — The National Advisory Committee on Meat and Poultry Inspection will meet here with U.S. Department of Agriculture officials on July 29 and 30.

Topics to be discussed include USDA's Food Safety and Quality Service plans and proposals for: controlling chemical contamination in meat and poultry products; expanding nitrosamine monitoring to include dry-cured bacon; and net weight.

Other discussion topics include: USDA's report on nitrosamine levels in cured products; recent designations of state inspection services; surveys on sal-

monella in poultry and pork sausage; and FSQS' 1980 legislative package.

The meeting, which is open to the public, begins at 1 p.m. on July 29 and again at 9 a.m. on July 30. It will be held in conference room "B" of the Departmental Auditorium, 12th and Constitution Avenue, N.W.

The committee advises the secretary of agriculture on issues pertaining to USDA's meat and poultry inspection program.
