

Pa. Youth bring home Jr. Angus honors

TIMONIUM, Md. — Several Pennsylvania Junior Angus members returned home with honors after the first Northeastern Heifer Show — the Star Spangled Classic — held on July 5 here at the Maryland State Fairgrounds.

Christine Shive, Seven Valleys, showed the Reserve Champion Bred and Owned Heifer, B V Pinkie Pride 49, a Walbridge Milestone calf.

Monique Sweigard, Halifax, exhibited the Calf Champion H F Enchantress 951 by Byergos Black Revolution 36.

Lancaster County's Ernest R. Frey, II, Quarryville, showed the Reserve Calf Champion Twin Oaks Princess Grace, a daughter of Sayre Patriot.

In the group of five heifers competition, Pennsylvania placed third, following New York and Ohio, first and second places respectively.

The first show of its kind in the Northeast, the Star Spangled Classic was kicked

off with 102 Angus heifers. To go along with the cattle, 69 showmen from 7 states, including Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut and Ohio competed.

Grand Champion of the show was the Intermediate Champion from the Owned Classes Sir Williams Patricia 982, a May calf by Wetonka 2446, was shown by Leland Boggs, Claverack, New York.

The Reserve Champion of the show was the Champion Bred and Owned Heifer, also from New York Rally Timberlee Duchess 249 by Sayre Patriot was shown by Jennifer Smalstig, Millbrook.

The Reserve Intermediate Champion, Queen Dolly 838 of Sayre, was shown by Dawn Bippert, Elma, New York.

Another Patriot daughter took the Reserve Junior Championship Blackcan

511L of Sayre was shown by Brad Richardson, Phelps New York.

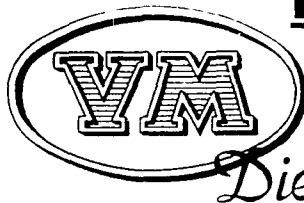

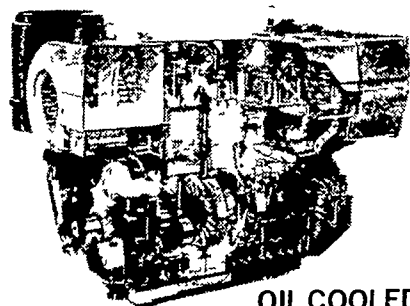
