Swine conference boasts crossbreds, discusses diseases, answers producer questions

LANCASTER - Close to 150 area hog producers escaped the sweltering heat on Tuesday and enjoyed a day here in the cool Farm and Home Center listening to management advice on hog economics, nutrition, diseases, breeding, and preventative health

The meeting was one of two conferences sponsored by the Ralston Purina Company and local dealers The other meeting was held on Wednesday at the Host Inn, Harrisburg

According to Purina's Gary Anderson, these were the first meetings attempted by the company at addressing the hog industry

He noted they had previously sponsored similar meetings, but for the dairy industry

Anderson informed the group of producers that the consumption of pork has increased 14 percent and is now estimated at 65 pounds per person — up from 57 pounds He noted the consumers consumption of beef has dropped to 70 pounds per year which will help the continued demand for pork products

Pointing out that it takes an average of \$38 to produce one pound of pork, Anderson advised the producers to work with a sharp pencil and know exactly what the cost

of every part of their operation is

'There is no room for mediocrity in hog producing," he said, noting that times where arkets are low tends to weed out the poor managers in the hog industry

To help the producers stay in business, Purina's Larry DeGoey advised those in attendance on nutrition and how it applies to finishing

Covering many of the intricacies of his field, the nutritionist pointed out that producers who feed a high energy ration need to watch


