and Markets; and William Greene, livestock extension associate at Cornell University.

A major topic discussion was the use of A.I. and whether there's justification to purchase a bull for a herd of eight to 10 cows. Suggestions included leasing a bull, owning a bull in partnership, or raising a bull calf and using him as a yearling and then selling him. A.I. selection should be made on the basis of herd goals, said Jim Herman. He asked "Are you interested in strengthening the maternal

side of your herd or is your primary goal to make dollars?"

Another topic was what some in the audience termed a 'communication gap for the breeder of a small herd.' Bob Morrison pointed out it was up to the individual breeder to take the initiative and seek needed information. He suggested visiting other operations, making use of fieldmen and Extension personnel.

Record keeping, marketing and management practices, also were discussed during the lively dialogue between audience and panel.

Ed Bible, editor of The Polled Hereford World, spoke about communication and merchandising for the breeder with a small herd.

The Breeder Forum and Junior Workshop held at Stonen Farm, owned by Louis Buisch Jr., were unique in that they were independently sponsored by the farm and not by a breed organization. Both events were open to all interested persons regardless of breed of cattle owned.

The need for such educational programs was evidenced by the support of the beef industry and the youth in their attendance and participation in the Forum and Workshop.
